Rosary Month: In this month of May, there will be recitation of the Holy Rosary 10 -15 min before Mass. Anyone can lead. Wednesday (Glorious Mystery), Friday (Sorrowful Mystery), Saturday (Joyful Mystery), Sunday (Glorious or any Mystery), Thursday (Luminous Mystery).

THE NEW LECTIONARY: The Lectionary, which is the book that contains the Scripture Readings for Mass and the Sacraments is changing as part of the continuing process of revising Liturgical Translations. This process began in 2011 with the Roman Missal. The New Lectionary will use both the English Standard Version – Catholic Edition of the Bible and the Abbey Psalter for the Psalms. The changes are intended to make the Biblical Translations more faithful to the original Languages, to reflect current Biblical Scholarship, and to provide a Text for use in Liturgical setting that is more pro-claimable and, where appropriate, more inclusive. **The New Lectionary will become mandatory for use in all Catholic Parishes and Mass centres in England and Wales and in Scotland from Advent 2024.** CTS was appointed by the local Bishops' Conferences to publish the official ritual editions of the Lectionary for England and Wales, and Scotland. These will be the only editions authorised for use in these countries. Alongside the New Lectionary, CTS is publishing a range of resources, including people's Missals, Abbey Psalter Psalms & Canticles, Liturgical Music – including new settings for psalmody at Mass. The New Sunday Missal costs **£19.95. Parishioners are encouraged to order for "The Daily Missal"** which has the readings for all year round, not only Sundays, instead of the Sunday Missal. Children's Pilgrimage to Walsingham: will take place **Tuesday 28th May** (during half-term). There will be a procession that starts in the village at 10:45am and progresses along the former railway line with pauses for prayers and hymns. Mass will be celebrated at the chapel of Reconciliation at 12 noon (servers from parishes would be welcome). After Mass there will be a picnic before moving to the beach at Wells-next-the-Sea, weather permitting.
