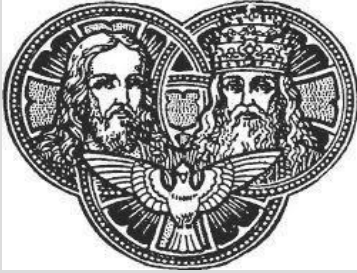

End of the Season of Ordinary Time - Feast of Christ the King: The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, referred to as the Feast of Christ the King, Christ the King Sunday or Reign of Christ Sunday, is a feast in the liturgical year which emphasises the true kingship of Christ. The feast was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI in the Catholic Church. In 1970 the feast was moved from October to the last Sunday of Ordinary Time and thus to the end of the liturgical year. The earliest date on which the Feast of Christ the King can occur is 20 November and the latest is 26 November.

Clergy Thoughts: Theme: Christ Our King: The Liturgical year began on the First Sunday of Advent, and it ends today with the Feast of Christ the King. During the Liturgical year, we re-live the life of Christ and try to immerse ourselves in the kingdom he came to establish. It is right, therefore, to ask yourselves at this end of the year: "Is Christ more king of my life now than a year ago?" May Christ be our King now and forever. Amen. Fr Alex
